Ductless heat pump

- \$1,200 rebate
- Equipment must be certified by the Air-Conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Institute (AHRI) as a mini-split heat pump, use inverter technology and be a minimum of 1.0 ton in heating mode
- Must use electric resistance heat as primary heating source which includes electric zonal (baseboard, cable, wall heater), electric hydronic or electric forced-air furnace
- Must install at least one unit in the main living area of the home. Equipment only installed in a bedroom is not eligible
- Cannot have an existing heat pump or natural gas service, even if only used for cooking
- Manufactured homes do not qualify for this rebate
- Customers who do not qualify for this rebate may qualify for the air-source heat pump rebate if equipment meets efficiency requirements

Electric forced-air furnace (FAF) to air-source heat pump conversion

- \$1,500 rebate
- Written pre-approval required. Must submit additional form found at **PSE.com/Rebates** to PSE and receive written pre-approval prior to installation
- Must have an existing FAF that is used as primary heating source
- Combination of air handler, indoor and outdoor units must be AHRI performance certified ducted air-source heat pump with an 8.5 HSPF and 14 SEER or higher
- Cannot have an existing heat pump, including a ductless heat pump
- Cannot have an existing gas furnace or gas boiler
- Electric zonal customers are not eligible
- Customers who do not qualify for this rebate may qualify for the air-source heat pump rebate if equipment meets efficiency requirements

General qualifications

- Rebate application must be submitted within 30 days of equipment installation
- Qualifying electric equipment must be installed in PSE's electric service area
- Applies to existing single-family properties (including manufactured) or individually-metered attached housing with four units or less
- One space heating rebate per PSE metered residential customer
- Cannot be combined with any other space heating rebate except as noted on this form
- PSE metered residential customers that previously received a space heating rebate from PSE do not qualify for another rebate except as noted on this form
- Must install to comply with all federal, state and local code requirements
- PSE may inspect installation for compliance with qualifications

Air-source heat pump

- Tier 1 \$200 rebate (8.5 HSPF/ 14 SEER)
- Tier 2 \$350 rebate (9.0 HSPF/ 14 SEER)
- Tier 3 \$800 rebate (10.0 HSPF/ 16 SEER)
- · Heat pump system must be AHRI performance certified
- Customers who do not qualify for the ductless heat pump or electric FAF to heat pump conversion rebates can qualify for this rebate if equipment meets efficiency requirements

Geothermal heat pump

- \$1,500 rebate
- Must install ENERGY STAR[®] qualified equipment
- Cannot have an existing geothermal heat pump installed

Air-source heat pump sizing and lock-out control

- \$300 rebate
- Customers planning a new installation, or submitting for an existing installation, must provide PSE sizing documentation completed by a qualified contractor indicating the system is properly sized for the home and meets PSE program requirements to 30 degrees balance point. Download the sizing document at PSE.com/Rebates
- Air-source heat pumps must have 8.5 HSPF/ 14 SEER
- Lock-out control for electric auxiliary heat (electric forced-air furnaces) must be set to 40 degrees F and must have a sensor installed capable of reading outdoor temperature. Propane or natural gas furnaces installed as auxiliary heat are not eligible for this rebate
- Rebate may only be combined with PSE's air-source heat pump upgrade rebate or forced-air furnace to air-source heat pump conversion rebate

Converting to natural gas

When available, PSE recommends using natural gas directly for space and water heating. You may be eligible for conversion rebates.
